For the young African creative generation or from the diaspora, the continent no longer represents only the land of origins, but that of opportunities. We must support these actors, entrepreneurs, have a strategy for training, deploying these creative professions which range from the least qualified to the most qualified.

*This is why 3D Netinfo and its partners will launch the first **African Metaverse Academy**, in order to train more than 300 young people and women for free in Metaverse professions (Blockchain, Crypto, IA, NFT, VR, AR, 3D, Gaming, Design, etc.) in more than 15 African countries from July 2022.*

This project will target young developers between the ages of 18 and 30. We will select 300 young people who will participate in the project with a quota of 20 young people for each partner country. A quota will be reserved for other young people from countries not represented and will be selected on their motivation. All will benefit from training and support sessions for the production of prototypes or immersive applications relating to African cultural heritage.

*Through **Africa Metaverse Academy** we demonstrate that Africa is not behind, and that we believe in all the opportunities offered by the Metaverse and Web 3.0.*

We have the youth, the potential and the talents, it is up to us to bring them to fruition. So apply and try your luck for this free training which will take place from July to December 2022 online.
